BOOKING CONDITIONS

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Visitors must comply with the rules of golf as laid down by the Royal and Ancient Golf of St. Andrews, and the Rules and byelaws of Castlerock Golf Club. The strict observance of the “Etiquette of Golf” is essential.
- Tee times may be booked in advance by telephone and are subject to a 25% deposit. Deposits can be made using a Visa or Mastercard credit card or an American Express card. Tee times will be held provisionally for two weeks, at which point if a deposit has not been received the tee times will be released.
- Green fees are required to be paid, in full, 28 days in advance and are non-refundable with the only exception being when the links are closed. An e-mail reminder will be sent by the Office when fees are due. Non payment by the specified date will result in an automatic cancellation of the reservation.
- Tee times must be strictly adhered to. Where visitors run over their allotted time, there is no guarantee that latecomers can be accommodated. Organisers are requested to ask participants to arrive at the Club 30 minutes before tee-off to ensure that no delay occurs.
- All visitors are requested to check in with the Professional Shop upon arrival.
- The accepted playing time for 18 holes at Castlerock is 4 hours (4-ball format). Slow play is not acceptable and players taking excessive time will be warned by the Ranger, and may be asked to give way if they are holding up the group behind.

Caddies / Golf Carts

- Caddies can be reserved in advance by telephone through the Caddy Master. To avoid disappointment, please give notice of your requirements when booking. The recommended rate for a caddy is £25 and £15 for a bag carrier (excluding gratuity) and should be made in cash at the end of each round.
- Self-drive golf carts (4 in number) are available for hire to all visitors at a cost of £25 per round and can be reserved in advance by telephone.

Dress Code

- Smart dress is essential in the Clubhouse and on the Links. The following items of dress are unacceptable at all times;
- Track or leisure suits, football shirts/jerseys, singlets, sleeveless or collarless shirts, untailored shorts, garments displaying slogans, and denims.
- Golf shoes **MUST** be worn on the links, and are **NOT** permitted in the Clubhouse.

Catering

A full catering service is operated on a daily basis and evening meals are served in the dining room. In the wintertime opening hours are reduced. To avoid any disappointment it is advisable to inform the caterer of any special group requirements at least two weeks before play.
